Rules and regulations A.0.2.4 Use of Master logger

The competitor must declare which logger is the master logger. It should be clear that the master logger will be the only logger used for scoring the flight. Only when this log is not complete the scoring team will ask the competitor to use the backup. Even for the jury the backup logger should not be used.

Local rules, C.13.2 “Final of 4”

The finals of the Air Navigation Race competition will take place on August 23rd 2024, Friday. Only 4 best crews from the qualification with lowest number of penalties will compete in final for the winner in navigation.

- The best four crews (with the lowest number of penalty points from the 7 qualification rounds) will compete in additional navigation flight (so-called “final of 4”).
- The winner of the “final of 4” navigation flight is the winner of the navigation competition (“Air Navigation trophy”).
- The winner of the combined trophy is the crew with the lowest combined penalties (from the 7 qualification rounds and the landing competition).

Point A.4.3.1 c) In case of a draw between two or more competitors the crew with lower number of penalties from the 7 qualification rounds will be placed in the higher position.
