3 Pilot licence for flying in France.

- Valid pilot license
- Valid pilot medical certificate
- Valid FAI Sporting License
- Valid personal insurance policy

Case 1.1: Pilots with an ICAO license flying an aircraft registered in the same country as their pilot license, do not need any special authorization from the French civil aviation authority. Just send us at wrfc2023@ff-aero.fr, a copy (scan) of your

- Valid pilot license for flight
- The authentication of the license, issued by the authority that issued the license, indicating compliance with ICAO (document less than one month old at the date of application)
- Valid medical certificate

Case 1.2: Pilots with an ICAO license flying an aircraft registered in the same country as their pilot license, *if they live in Europe*, need a valid European licence. In this case, send us at wrfc2023@ff-aero.fr, a copy (scan) of your

- a valid European pilot licence for flight
- a valid medical certificate

Case 2: it concerns Chile, China, Great-Britain, Serbia and South Africa.

Pilots with an ICAO license who want to fly on a French registration aircraft, will need a special authorisation from the French civil aviation authority. To get it, you'll have to pay 80€ per licence <u>here</u> and must file the form <u>here</u> with (one form per country for all the pilots) and send it to <u>wrfc2023@ff</u><u>aero.fr</u> **before 30th May** with a copy (scan) of:

- Valid ICAO pilot license
- The authentication of the license, issued by the authority that issued the license, indicating compliance with ICAO (document less than one month old at the date of application)
- Valid ICAO pilot medical certificate
- Copy of the payment of 80 € per licence
